Petr Kaiser is currently serving as Special Envoy for Science Diplomacy at the Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He advises the MFA leadership on issues related to international collaboration in research and innovation, He also develops projects and organizes events and mission to promote bilateral and multilateral partnerships in this area.
