In 2010 she was elected a member of the Parliament of the Czech Republic.

From 2010 to 2013 she served as vice-chair of the Budget Committee, a member of the Committee on Public Administration and Regional Development, the chair of the Permanent Commission on Family Issues and Equal Opportunities and the chair of the Subcommittee on Banking, Insurance and Financial Markets. From 2013 to 2017 she was the vice-chair of the Committee on European Affairs and from 2014 was a member of the Subcommittee on European Funds and Cross-Border Cooperation. In 2014 she became a member of the Czech Republic – Israel and the Czech Republic – United States Inter-Parliamentary Group. In 2015 she was elected chair of the Subcommittee on Migration and Asylum Policy. She was also a member of the Committee on Petitions from 2016.

From 2017 to 2021 she was a member of the Economic Committee and the Committee on European Affairs. In 2018 she became chair of the Subcommittee on Migration and Asylum Policy.
